

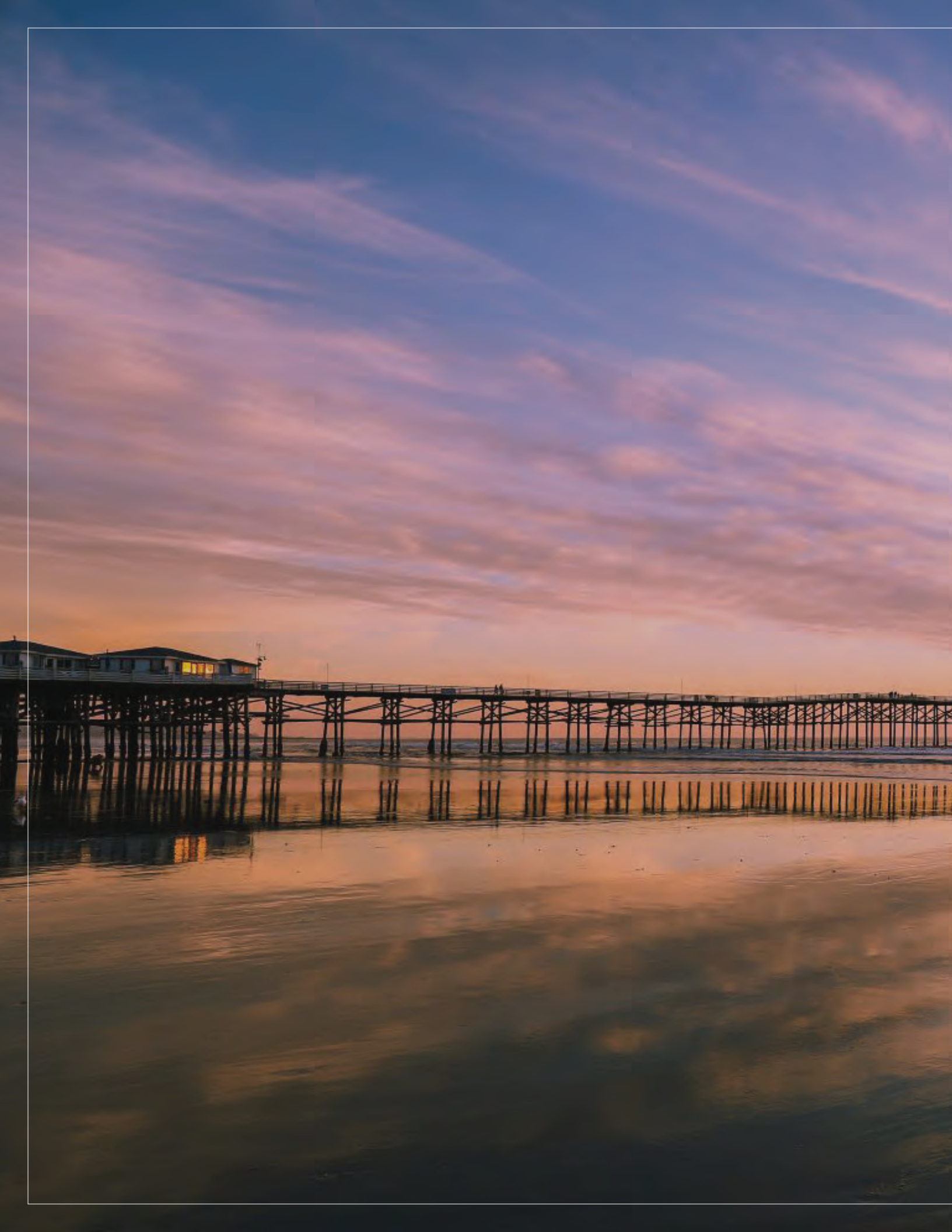

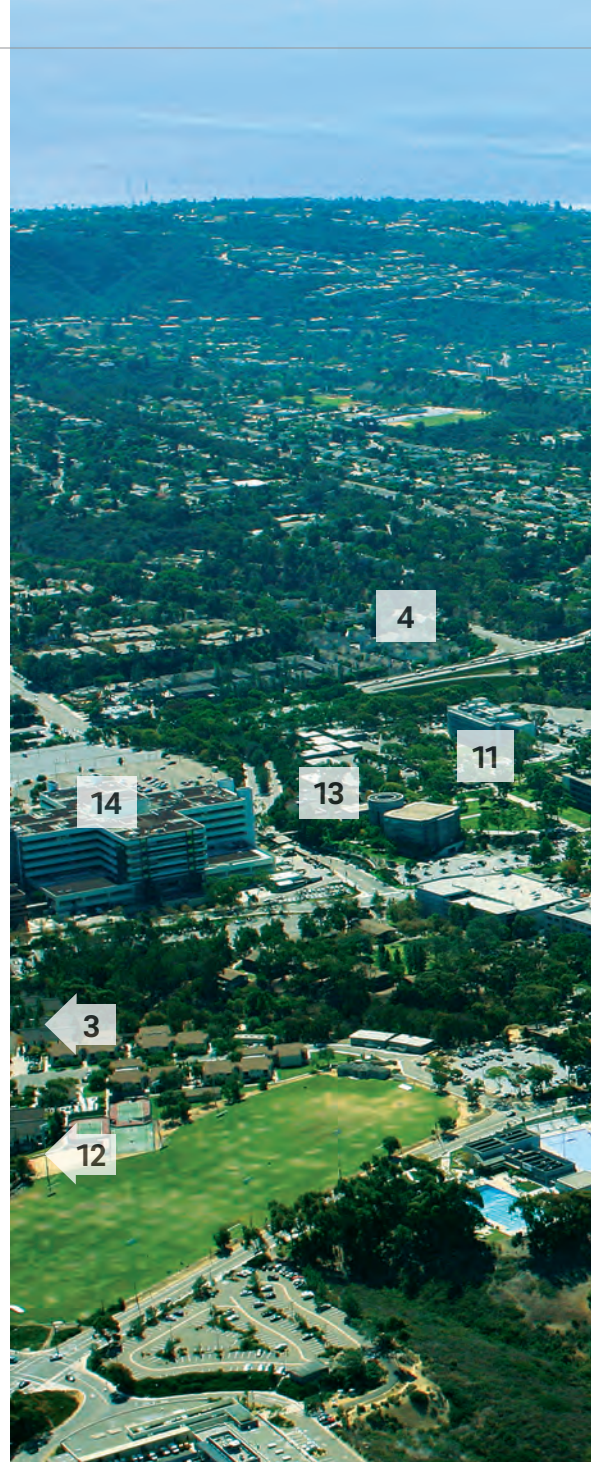

- **ACCESS TO PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:** The campus has easy access to the Blue Line of the San Diego Trolley and many bus links.
- **CLOSE TO DOWNTOWN:** UC San Diego is located 20km from downtown San Diego, easily accessible by Trolley.

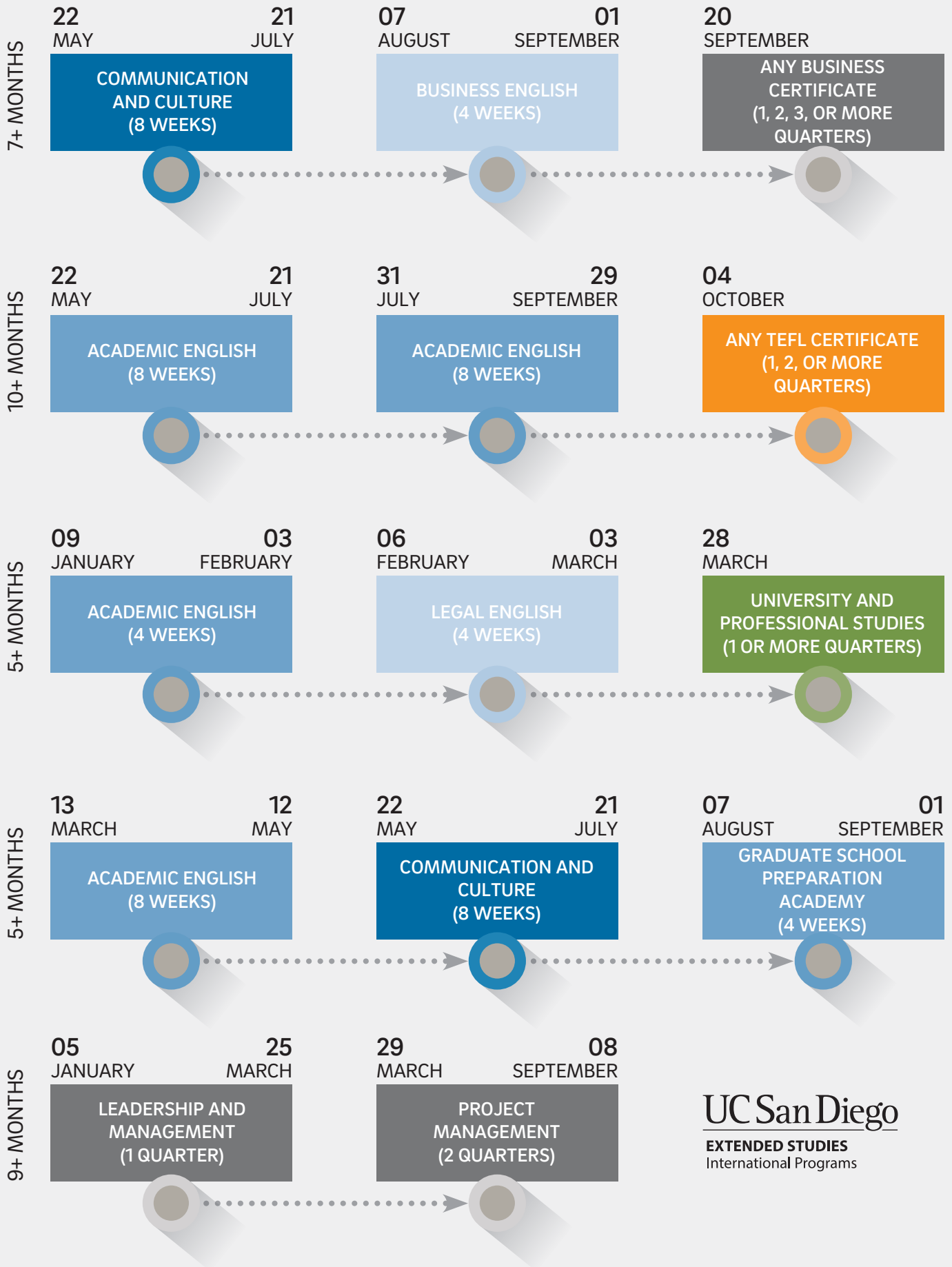
