ITPS is a 3-week course offered to learners from around the world at the No. 1-ranked school of pharmacy in the United States. Through this program, participants will develop their knowledge and skills in key areas including the drug development pipeline (from discovery to outcomes), pharmaceutical sciences, pharmacy practice, and professional development. ITPS exposes learners to world class professors, cutting-edge research, and innovative technologies as we explore the lifecycle of drugs and vaccines in our modern world.

Participants will get immersed in the culture and experience life as a University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill student. Upon successful completion of the program, participants will receive four credit hours and an official UNC transcript.

We invite all current and future scientists and pharmacists to join us in Chapel Hill for this unique and engaging program. For those unable to attend in-person, we also offer a virtual option where participants will receive a certificate of completion.

Residential Program Structure

Instruction hours per week: 30

Course components:

- Presentations
- Site visits to local pharmacies and pharmaceutical companies
- Skills labs (e.g., pharmacy compounding, HPLC, excel)
- Cultural activities

Course schedule (Monday through Friday):

- 8:30 to 11:30 - presentations
- 11:30 to 13:00 - lunch break
- 13:00 to 16:00 - site visit, skills lab, or cultural activity



*Virtual participants will get access to the presentations to watch live or recorded at their convenience as well as a weekly recitation to engage with UNC faculty and students.

What is included in the residential program fee?



Program fee includes:

- Housing
- Food (breakfast, lunch, and dinner)
- International health insurance
- Transportation for program activities
- Class tuition (four credit hours)
- Cultural activities

Frequently Asked Questions

When do I need to register by?

- Registration for the residential program closes on 8 March, 2024. For the early registration discount (\$250 USD discount), you will need to register by 31 January, 2024.
- Registration for the virtual program closes on 21 June, 2024. For the early registration discount (\$50 USD discount) you will need to register by 30 April, 2024.

Where is UNC Eshelman School of Pharmacy located?

UNC Eshelman School of Pharmacy is located in Chapel Hill, North Carolina, USA. Chapel Hill is a college town, with easy access to North Carolina's state capital of Raleigh, as well as Research Triangle Park, which is the largest research park in the United States. Located midway between New York City and Miami, Chapel Hill is only a 2 hour drive to either the mountains to the west, or the beach to the east.

This program is appropriate for learners in undergraduate programs, graduate programs, or working professionals. It will introduce you to core concepts in pharmacy and pharmaceutical sciences, then expand on them by discussing innovative research currently happening in the field.
